

## Responsibly Produced Peat in process to grant certificate

Date of publication 10 October, 2024

Responsibly Produced Peat intends to grant the RPP-certificate to the company named in this document. This intended decision is based on the fact that the company meets the requirements of the RPP certification scheme version 3.0. The fulfilment of the criteria is checked by an independent qualified inspector, including inspection at location.

<b>Site description</b>	
<u>Environment of the location:</u> The site is located on relatively sparsely populated area mainly used for forestry and agriculture. There are no protected areas or permanent habitats of protected species near the Ebbarp peat production site. The closest cultural heritage objects are located on the mineral soil and the protection zones of these objects are located at least 45 m distance from the peat production site.	
<u>Protected areas:</u> There are no adjacent areas with important natural values	
<u>Time in exploitation:</u> The first peat extraction activities in the area started in 2009, the site was fully built up by 2013.	
<u>Expected end of production based on peat reserves:</u> About 2040

**Remarks resulting from inspection:**

"The landowners have stated that once peat extraction is complete, they require a forest, with small areas designated for pools. This was agreed upon during the permitting process and can be considered a contractual obligation.
